FAQ's

WHAT IS EMERGENCY FIRST AID AT WORK

Emergency First Aid at Work develops the First Aid skills of an individual. When these skills are applied, they can help save a life until Emergency Services arrive.

The qualification covers a wide range of essential skills including how to manage in an emergency CPR and how to and when to put an injured person into the recovery position.

Learning these skills will give the individual the knowledge and confidence to assist a person in need of Emergency First Aid.

IS THERE A REQUALIFICATION REQUIRED?

The qualification is valid for a period of 3 years at which time candidates will need to successfully take the course again to update their certificate.

HOW LONG IS THE COURSE?

The QNUK Level 2 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work is made up of 1 unit lasting 10 Guided Learning Hours.

HOW AM I ASSESSED?

Unit 1 :Candidates are assessed by sitting a multiple choice assessment consisting of 15 multiple choice questions and through practical assessment.

The multiple choice paper is to be marked by the trained instructor/assessor.

WHAT IS THE PASS MARK?

Candidates must complete and pass the single units in order to receive QNUK's Level 2 Award.

Unit 1 : Multiple Choice – Candidates must correctly answer 10 out of the 15 questions asked.

Practical assessment – Candidates must demonstrate their competence in all of the listed assessment areas for secondary assessment of casualty.

DO I NEED ANY EQUIPMENT TO DELIVER?

Equipment will be needed in order to support all aspects of the training. Tutors should ensure good hygiene practices are used. Where possible There should be 1 CPR manikin to every 4 students; child and baby manikins should be available. There should also be sufficient supplies of dressing and bandages.

HOW TO I REGISTER AS A PROVIDER FOR EMERGENCY FIRST AID AT WORK?

Approved QNUK Centres should contact QNUK by email or phone to advise they wish to offer the Award within their provision. The Centre must then provide QNUK with details of the tutor(s) delivering the award before confirmation of extension of provision is given

Non- Approved QNUK Centres should complete the QNUK Centre Recognition Form and supply QNUK with details on tutor(s) delivering the award. QNUK will review your application and inform you of their decision within 7 days, this may take longer in busy periods but you will be advised if this is likely to occur.

WHAT ARE THE COSTS ATTACHED?

It is free to extend your provision to include the award.

The QNUK Level 2 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work (QNUK) assessment costs:

£5 – assessment only

£7 – Assessment and recommended book for candidates.

You will receive a presentation to assist you in your delivery, free of charge on your 1st order of 10 student assessments and books.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS TO TEACH EMERGENCY FIRST AID AT WORK?

Tutors must have the expertise to speak with confidence on the subject being taught at this level.

It is compulsory that tutors teaching the award have a formal teaching qualification. Please see examples below :

- Have experience of delivering this type of qualification within the past 2 years
- Current First Aid at Work Certificate
- Current First Aid Instructor Certificate
- Be currently assessing/moderating/verifying in this subject area
- Membership of a relevant professional sector body/institute
- PTLLS/CTLLS/STLLS
